Brief description of program or funding including funding distribution method (formula or competitive grant):

The USDA/FNS Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants and Children (WIC) will provide \$100 million to State agencies for management information systems, EBT pilots and other critical systems upgrades through a competitive grant application process. The Department of Health’s WIC Program applied for one ARRA

grant that was due June 26, 2009. It was RFA # 4 for WIC entitled WIC Miscellaneous Technology Grant. Florida WIC requested \$3,874,445 to assist with the estimated costs for the first 18 months of a WIC data system transfer and implementation project. The timeframes associated with Florida's grant application are April 2010 through September 2011. The program understands that grant awards should be announced in September 2009.
